Covid 19 Lead:

An Event Covid Lead assisted by a Team of Club provided Covid Officers will be present at the event, in order to ensure compliance with social distancing guidelines and other Covid advice in place at the time of the competition or required by the Facility Management. It is expected that each Club will provide their own Covid Officers to supervise their Club Swimmers. Full information will be communicated at a later date,

While recognizing that Covid restrictions may change prior to the Event a decision has been made there will be no spectators permitted at the Event regardless of any changes in Covid guidelines that are in place. The Event will Live Streamed to the SENE You Tube Channel. To note that under existing guidelines the capacity of the Sunderland Pool Hall is 200 individuals

Entries will be accepted from Swim England Category 2 Members registered as Members of NDSA Clubs

Age for swimmers is at 31 December 2021

Due to the lack of recent swimming the Times are **Consideration Times** and do **NOT** guarantee an Entry. These times are derived from the LC & SC British Swimming Rankings from 1 September 2019 and Level X times submitted during 2020 & 2021.

Entries must be made by the relevant Club Officer using the Online Entry System. Should any clarification be required contact the Entry Manager by email.

Payment of the Event Entry Fee £8.50 per Event must be made via Paypal at the time of entry. Unless this action is completed Entries will not be made.

Entries from Para-Swimmers who hold a British Para-Swimming Para Classification are permitted, and are not subject to the consideration times. These entries must be made by email direct to the Entry Manager.

Entries will open no later than 21 June 2021, and close on the 9 July 2021. The information including the relevant Web Links will be emailed to the Club Secretary. Following the closing date, the entries and Event Schedule received will be reviewed, and following this review if the event is oversubscribed entries will be rejected to ensure that the meet stays within timelines and Covid restrictions in place at that time. Rejections will be made fairly across all age groups based on entry time, entirely at the discretion of the Entry Manager and may not be the subject of any appeal. Conversely if we are in a position to accept additional entries this will be considered.

There will be no charge for those individuals carrying out any duties at the event. There may be restrictions on numbers of Coaches Team Managers and Club Covid Officers due to Covid restrictions. Clubs are asked to consider the numbers on poolside, and to ensure that the fine balance between having enough personnel present to safeguard their swimmers, and too many to observe social distancing, should this still be required at the time of the meet.

Clubs will be required to submit a list of those Coaches Team Mangers and Club Covid Officers with relevant contact details (email or telephone) to the promoter 1 week before the competition. Clubs are required to keep a register of members of their Club including swimmers present at each session in the event that this information is required for Track and Trace or other Covid purposes .

All competitors and other attendees are required to adhere to the conditions of the competition to ensure that we all stay compliant and safe. Anyone failing to follow the conditions will be refused access or removed from the venue and no refund will be offered.

Disclaimer:

While every reasonable effort will be made for the competition to happen, the regular changes in Covid restrictions continue to provide some unpredictability when planning competitions. The conditions for the Event and whether the Event ultimately take place is dependent on the restrictions in place on the venue, the sport and the participants.

No guarantee can be given by the Promoter that the Event will take place as proposed, or on any particular date. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel the Event without notice and without liability for doing so if required. The Event will not be rescheduled if it is unable to take place on the scheduled dates.

In the event of cancellation or abandonment of the Event, refunds if any, will be made at the absolute discretion of the Promoter. The Promoter will have no legal liability to make a refund or to pay any form of consequential or indirect damage such as loss of enjoyment, travel, catering and accommodation.
